 the dog park to see what they can do for us. She would like to see us be able to really reduce our premium
 but doesn't want to jeopardize board cover in any way. Eileen will begin contacting the company and
 agents on behalf of Friends of Midtown and invite him to come to one of our meetings to have a discussion
 with us about what the coverage would be.
- Molly brought up the Dog Park budget line and whether we want to reallocate the funds to other committees, the admin account, or whatever. We will discuss this at a future meeting after Molly and Eileen check in with Jodi.
